What is needed for New Student Registration?

Bring along the following:

**You must have all documents in order to complete registration:

- 1 Proof of Residency at least one of the following:
 - mortgage statement showing name and address of owner;
 - current tax statement; or
 - current lease agreement with one utility bill with same address
- 2 Official Birth Certificate
 - ---the birth certificate issued by the state, not the hospital copy
- 3 Current Immunization Record
- 4 Child's Social Security Card
- 5 Current Parent ID eg: Texas Driver License

**After August 6th, the next Registration Day for new students will be the first day of school: Wednesday, August 21
